Reference Style

In APA (7th edition) style, the reference for a journal article follows this structure:

Basic Format:

Author(s). (Year). Title of the article. Title of the Journal, Volume number (Issue number), page range. https://doi.org/xxx

Example:

Smith, J. A., & Brown, P. L. (2020). The impact of leadership on organizational performance in small businesses. *Journal of Business Management*, 45(3), 123-135. https://doi.org/10.1234/jbm.2020.04503

Key Points to Note:

- **Author(s):** Last name followed by initials, separated by a comma. Use "&" before the last author's name.
- Year: The year of publication is in parentheses, followed by a period.
- Title of the Article: Only the first word of the title and subtitle (if any), and any proper nouns are capitalized.
- Title of the Journal: Italicized and each major word is capitalized.
- **Volume and Issue Number:** The volume number is italicized, but the issue number is not (in parentheses).
- Page Range: The range of pages where the article appears.
- DOI: Include a DOI if available, formatted as a URL.

This example follows APA guidelines for citing journal articles, providing clear attribution for academic work.
